### **Meeting Notes**

#### **1. Meeting notes**

- Governor's budget to be debated over next couple months, due by June 15th
  - Some funding priorities will go out prior to then
- CSE's sponsored smart device legislation
  - [Link to bill language](#) and [summary document](#)
  - Rebate program focused on accelerating additional residential smart device DR
  - Point of sale rebate to fund 50% of device up front, administered by CEC and implemented by third-party
  - Smart thermostat rebates sunsetted at the end of 2020, need to drive additional devices
  - Funding questions remain to be resolved
  - Can be applied to IOUs, POUs, or 3Ps
- CLECA sponsored legislation: SB 204 (Dodd) base interruptible program
  - Direct response to August blackouts focused on C&I customers
  - Provides bill credit for electricity consumption reductions in <1 hour
  - Members: Shouldn't this just be done by the agencies?

- Assemblymember Ting looking to sponsor bill on demand response; wants our recommendations
  - Staff lead on 841 indicated Ting's interests in sponsoring a DR bill
  - Reserved a spot in bill package for demand management, no predilections on what content may look like
- CPUC President Batjer reappointed; appointments update
  - No further intel on appointments at this time
