Review 5/23 call with ED

- On 5/23, Greg and Clark had a call with Justin Galle to continue the dialogue between CEDMC and ED on solicitations.
- Topics covered during the meeting included:
 - Developments on 2-stage to 1-stage solicitations
 - Improvements to feedback process
 - Risk burden in IOU contracting
 - Actual vs. proposed in budgeting
- Reviewed plans for the next semi-annual 3P solicitations stakeholder meeting to be held on **July 11, 2022**.
 - CPUC will send a notice to service list later this week
 - CPUC would like to convene a *trade ally* panel and they have invited CEDMC to participate
 - In this session, they want to hear from implementers perspectives about the solicitations process (what works/what doesn't work)

Other Issues

- Bids have been due this week for IOU Summer Reliability programs, which have different bidding requirements... there might be some lessons learned coming out of those efforts.
 - The mandate model might also be a driver to better outcomes.

The meeting ended at 2:15, given the small attendance. We may look to reconfigure this working group going forward but we wanted to ask that more folks attend our next working group meeting on 6/28 as we begin to prepare for the semi-annual 7/11 stakeholder forum.
